We'll make a better job of it if you show us what you think - through your photographs
- and some of you will win prizes up to £100!

If you have an opinion about what you like best - long Stray views in the evening, perhaps, or a well designed new shop front - we'd like to know about it. What are the bad bits? And what have you seen that you think is unusual? Send us your photographs of buildings, the environment, planning matters, roads, people, events - anything that appeals to your shutter finger - taken in the last 3 years, within 3 miles of the Cenotaph in town, and with a distinctly Harrogate element to it.

The competition is open to all - residents, visitors, of any age - except full time professional photographers.
You can send us a maximum of 3 photographs, with the entry fee,
and all the proceeds will be donated to St Michael's Hospice.

Please submit prints on A4 photo paper only. They can be digital or film, black and white or colour, and they must be all your own work. The photographs are going to be judged in two categories - 18s & Under, and Over 18s. The entry fee for 18s & Under is £1.00 per photograph and for Over 18s £2.00 per photograph. In each category the first prize is £100, the second prize £50, and the third is £25. The judges will be looking at the quality of your photograph and how well it illustrates the point you're making - and there's a place on the entry form (below) if you'd like to add a few words of explanation.

The winners will be announced on the Harrogate Civic Society website, www.harrogatecivicsociety.org during week commencing 29 June. As part of Civic Societies Week, the winning photographs and a selection of other entries will be displayed at the Royal Hall on Tuesday 30 June between 10am and 6pm and, on that day at the Royal Hall, prizes will be presented to the winners at 5pm.

And that's about it - all you need to do is send your entry with the tear off slip below, and your cheque (payable to Harrogate Civic Society), to **The Photo Competition 2009, Harrogate Civic Society, 89 Valley Drive, Harrogate HG2 0JP**.
