Our Lady Immaculate and St Robert's Church

Robert Street, Harrogate, HG1 1HP

Our Lady Immaculate and St Robert's church has a proud heritage serving the area for over 150 years. Built in the Gothic Revival style with stained glass windows and unique stations of the cross.



Pannal Heritage Walk

Main Street, Pannal, HG3 1JZ

A heritage walk with a difference around the ancient village of Pannal. The walk will uncover stories of former residents and describe the heritage of the ancient buildings

Pateley Bridge Playhouse

Church Street, Pateley Bridge, HG3 5LB

This small theatre in Nidderdale, formerly a Primitive Methodist Chapel, has recently been refurbished as the Playhouse. Take a tour backstage and learn more about its history.



St Peter's in the heart of Harrogate

Cambridge Road, Harrogate, HG1 1PB

St Peter's Church is a striking example of Victorian architecture, a local landmark and home to a church community with a fascinating history and tales to tell. Talks on the history of the church and of the windows, with local expert guides on hand.



Ripley Village Historic Walkabout

Village Square, Ripley, HG3 3AY

Ripley is a historic Yorkshire estate village designed, built and managed for centuries by the Ingilby family. How was it planned and what connection does it have to French villages and the wild boar statue? All will be explained during this walk.

Schools and Schooldays in Harrogate

West Park UR Church, Victoria Avenue, HG1 1BL

An exhibition and talk, curated and hosted by historian Dr. Paul Jennings, showing the development of schools in Harrogate in the nineteenth century and through to the present day.



Sir Thomas Ingilby Talk - Rear Admiral Sir Robert Barrie

All Saints Church, Ripley, HG3 3AY

Hear the incredible story of Sir Thomas' relative Rear Admiral Sir Robert Barrie, a swashbuckling naval officer who enlisted at 10, fought in the Napoleonic wars and the war of 1812, captured numerous enemy ships, and is buried in All Saints Ripley.



[Valley Gardens Guided Walk: Wells, History and Horticulture](#)

Valley Drive, Harrogate, HG2 0JH

A walk through this Grade II listed park; home to 36 medicinal wells, specialist gardens and magnificent trees. Explore the park's development and how the horticulture and floral designs have changed over the years.

[Wesley Chapel Harrogate](#)

Oxford Street, Harrogate, HG1 1PP

Built in 1862 and a Grade II listed building, Wesley Chapel is a dominant landmark in Harrogate and has played a major role in town centre life. Music interludes will take place during the open days.



[St Wilfrid's Church Open Weekend](#)

South Stainley, Harrogate, HG3 3NE

The beautiful village church of St Wilfrid's will hold a flower festival to showcase the history of the church. The flower displays will be arranged by village volunteers and will use themes from local history.

Library, Victoria Avenue, Harrogate, HG1 1EG

In this talk Terry Williams will follow the history of sending messages up to the present day as we will soon see the cypher of King Charles III appearing on new post boxes. This talk will have an accompanying exhibition.
