A strategy has been compiled after extensive discussions between the Civic Society committee and representatives of the membership during Lockdown 2020

Returned questionnaires have given many ideas for the future, along with open criticism of what is currently negative about the Society and praise for those areas deemed to be very positive. The most frequently voiced concerns surround:

- a clear statement of what the Society is,
- what it stands for, and
- how that is communicated to the people of Harrogate

The strategy has looked at priorities for the Society and identified four main areas for development whilst involving more members in implementing them.

Going forward, four 'sub-groups' will work under the following headings and remits. The groups will be made up of committee and other Society members.

Development and Planning

- Monitoring / commenting on planning applications
- Being an influencer of good design
- Encouraging good modern architecture
- Promoting Design Awards
- Monitoring activity within Conservation Areas
- Encouraging /establishing pre-application discussions for key sites
